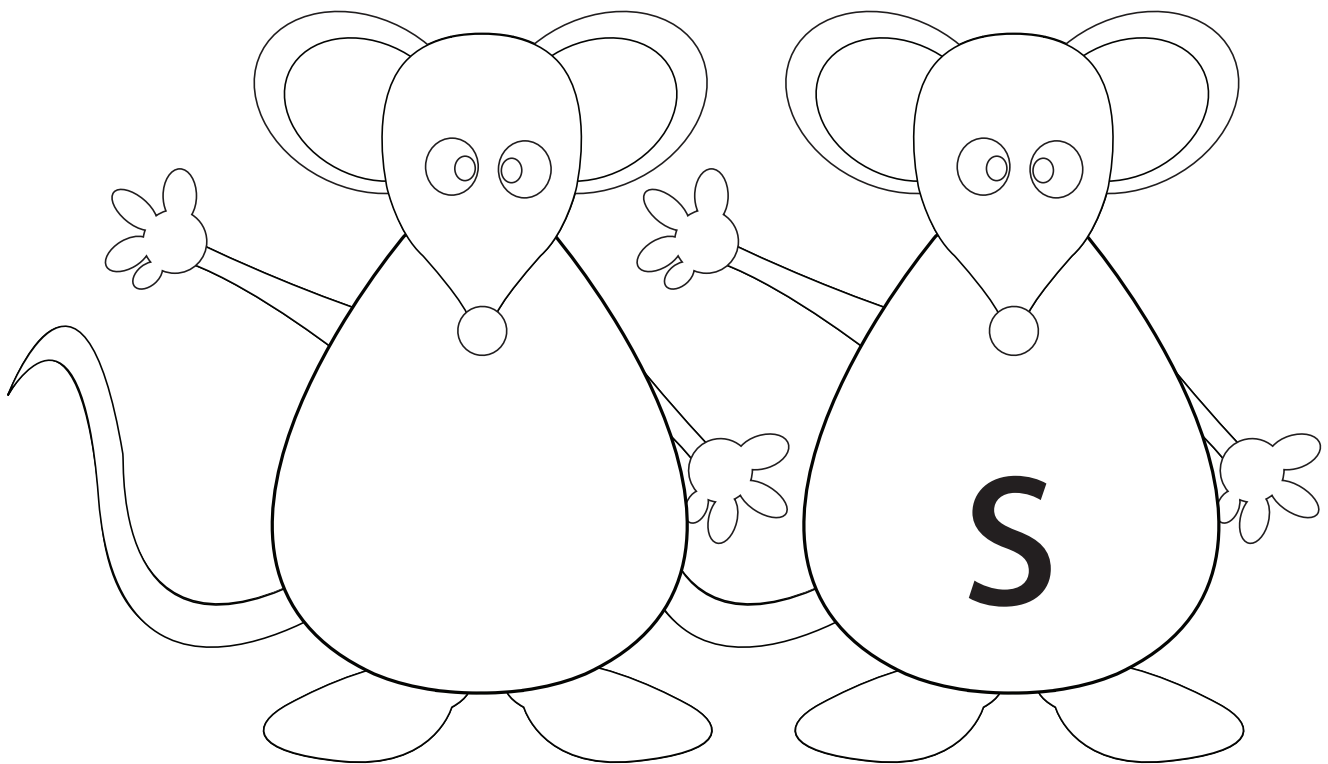


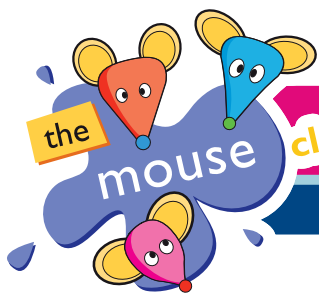
**Alphabet Sheets - find each letter's partner**

Each pair of mice has a letter missing, sometimes it is the capital, other times it is the lower case. At home you can help your child to find each letter partner. If children are new to learning about the alphabet, download the alphabet cards as an extra aid.

Teachers may decide to keep copies of these sheets in the writing corner. As an extension activity some children may find words or objects that start with each letter and either draw them on the sheet or have a go at writing and spelling them.

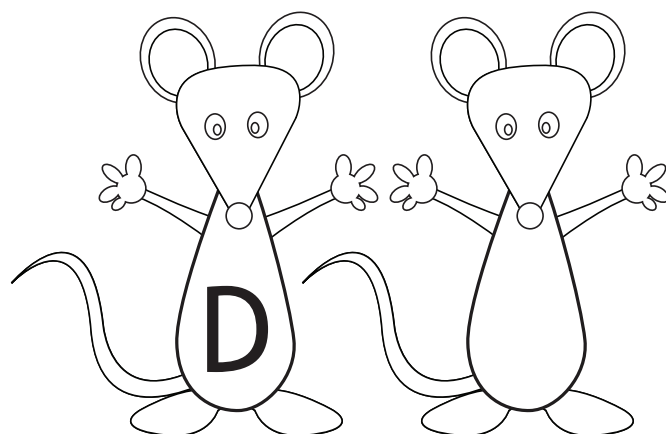
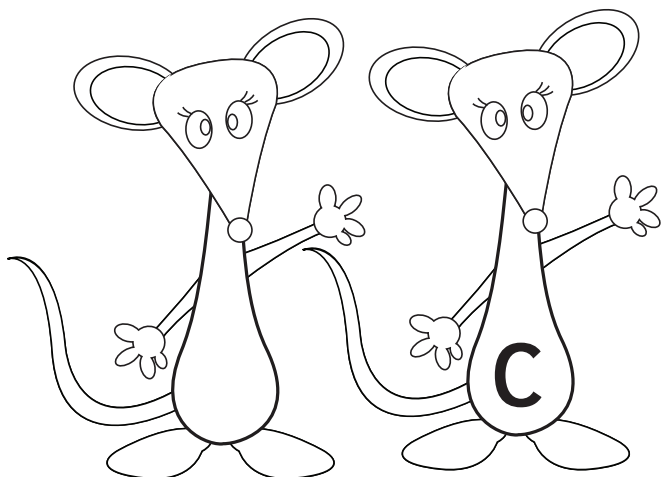
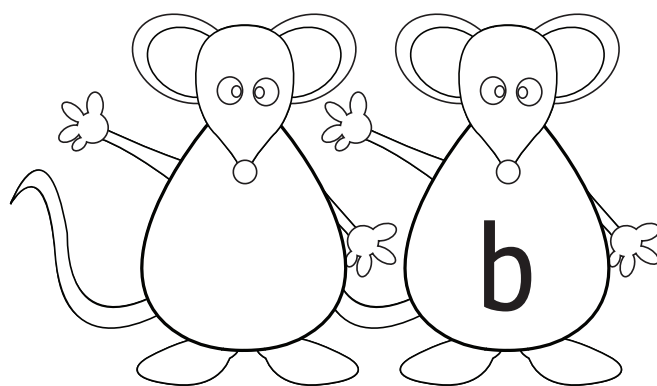
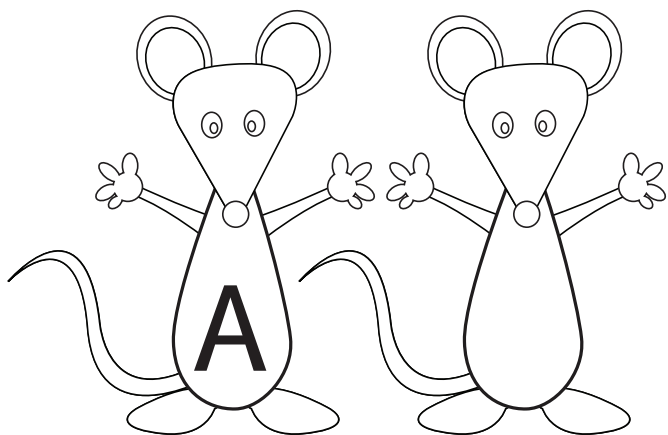




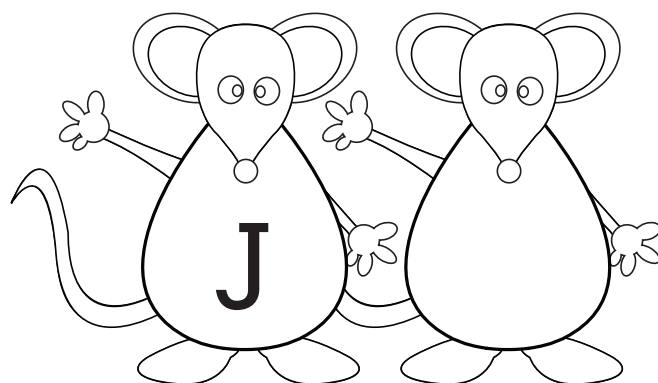
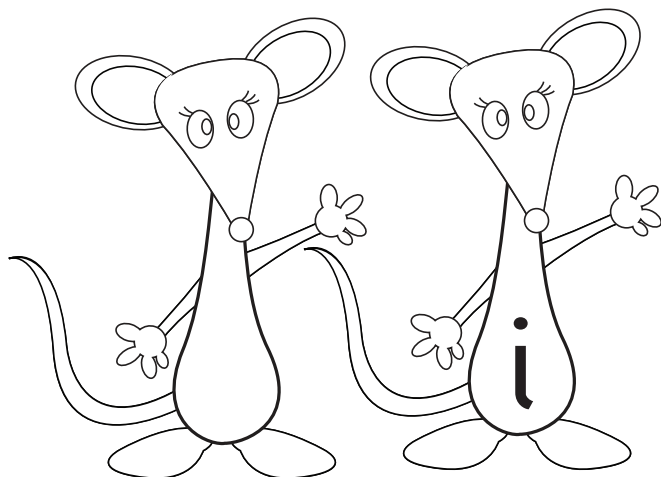
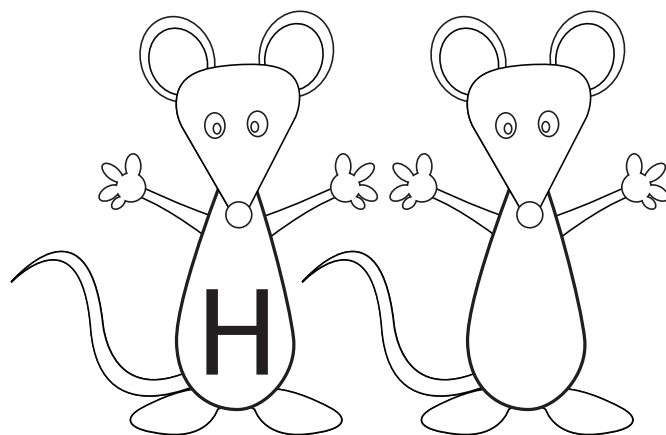
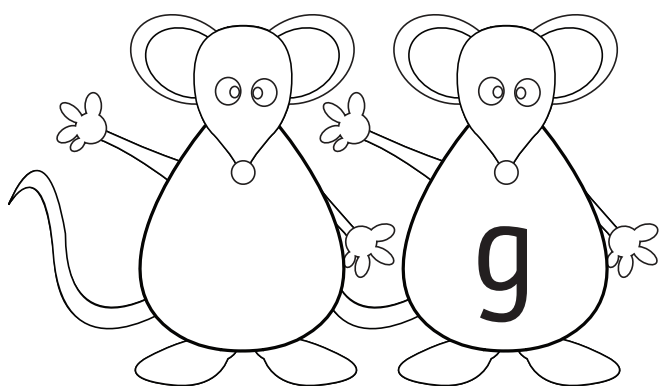
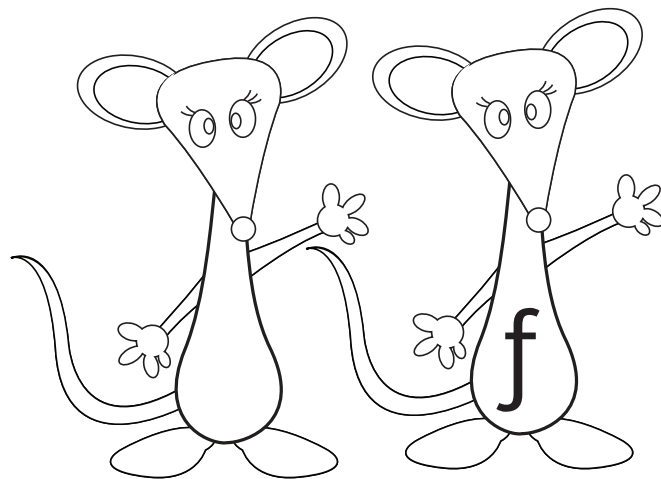
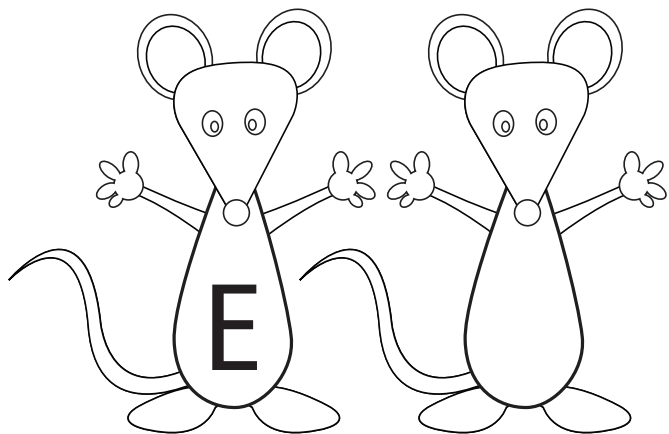
