

How to Draw a Bird

You will need: a pencil



a rubber



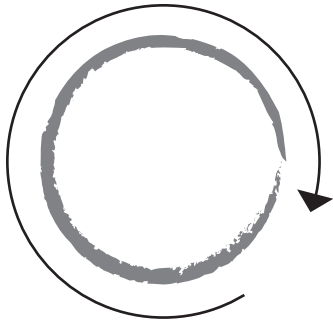
a pen



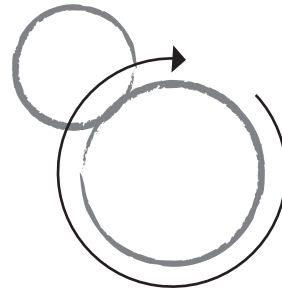
colouring crayons



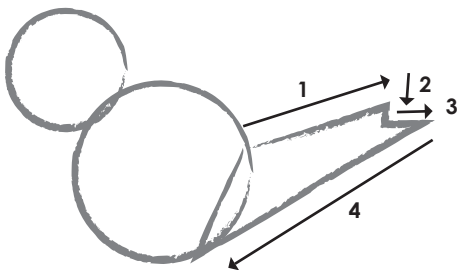
1. Use a pencil and draw a circle for the head.



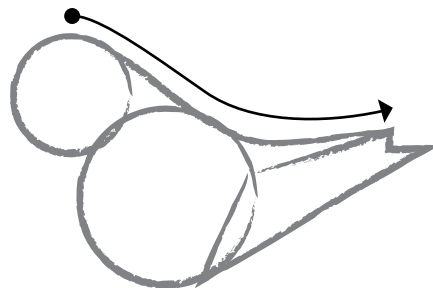
2. Under the circle draw a larger circle for the body.



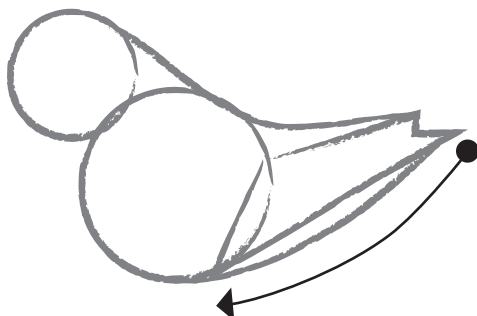
3. For the tail, draw 4 zig-zag lines.



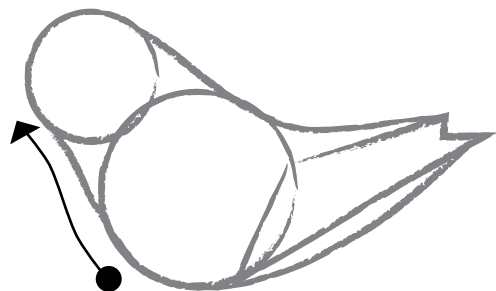
4. Join up the shapes by drawing a line from the top of the head to the tail.

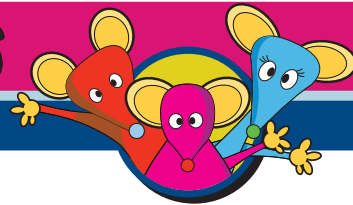


5. Draw a curved line joining the tip of the tail to the body.



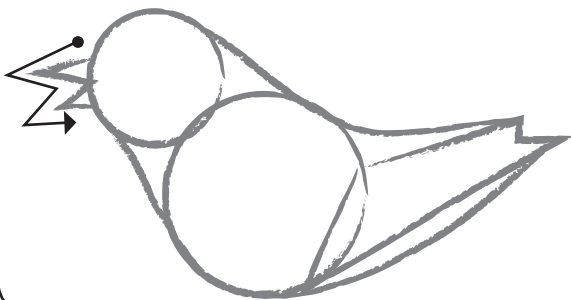
6. Connect the lower body to the head with another curved line.



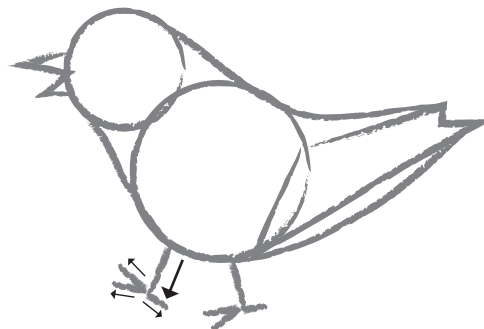


How to Draw a Daffodil

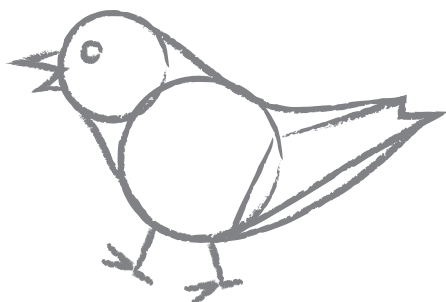
7. Draw 4 zig-zag lines for the beak.



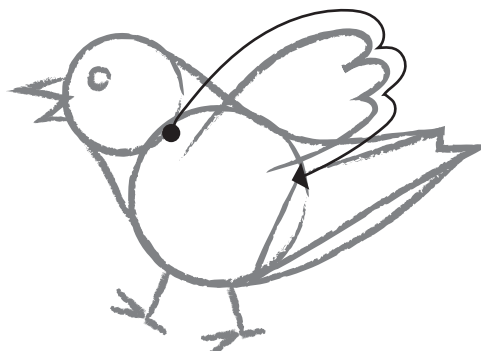
8. Add legs by drawing a line with 3 small lines at the end.



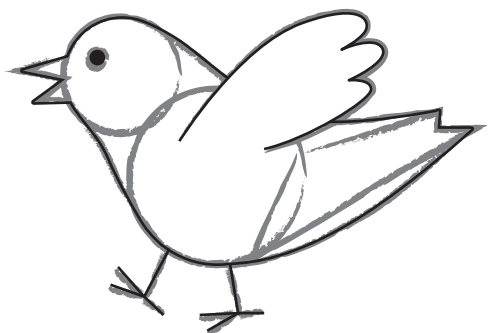
9. Draw a dot or circle for the eyes.



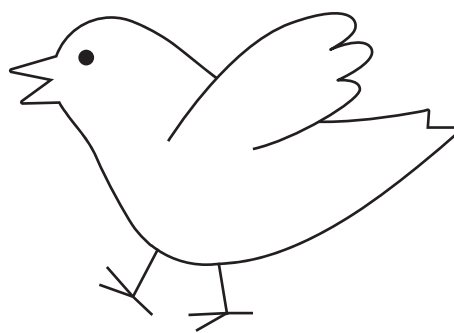
10. For the wing, draw a curvy line.

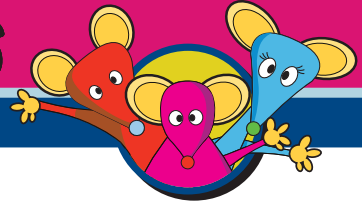


9. Now, use a pen to ink over your rough shapes.



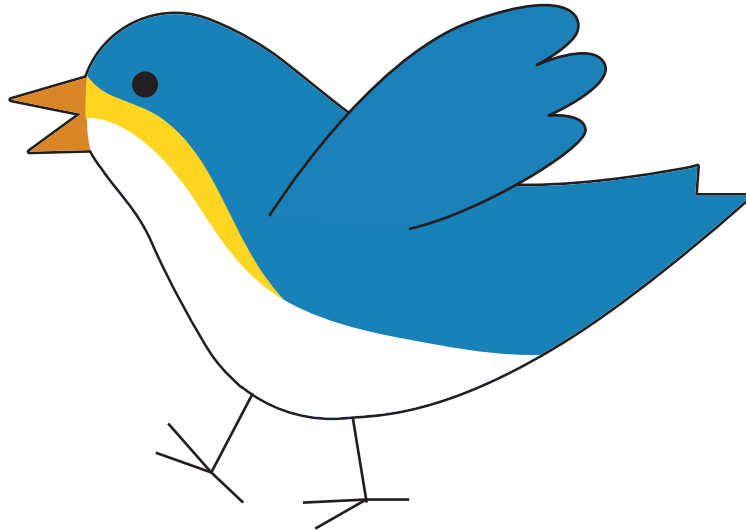
10. Once the ink has dried, rub out the pencil lines.

11. Finally, you can start colouring your bird!
