

Chocolate nests (makes 12)

You will need:

- 100g shredded wheat or crumbled weetabix
- 250g milk chocolate
- Small bun cases
- Bun tray
- Plastic bowl
- Wooden spoon



What to do:

1. Place the bun cases in the tray and set to one side.
2. Crumble the cereal into a plastic bowl.
3. Slowly melt the chocolate in a separate plastic bowl. You can do this in a microwave if you keep checking the chocolate after 30 seconds. Alternatively you can ask a grown up to help you melt the chocolate over a pan of hot water.
4. Keep stirring the chocolate until it has melted.
5. Spoon the melted chocolate over the cereal.
6. Try and make sure the cereal is well covered with the chocolate.
7. Spoon the mixture into the bun cases.
8. Press the mixture down with a wooden spoon.
9. With the blunt end of the wooden spoon, make a little well in the middle of each nest.
10. Leave to cool in the fridge for about 2 hours.
11. Add 3 little mini eggs to each nest.
12. Yummy, now they are ready to share with your family and friends. Enjoy!
