

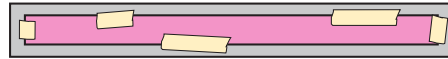
Party Crowns

You will need:

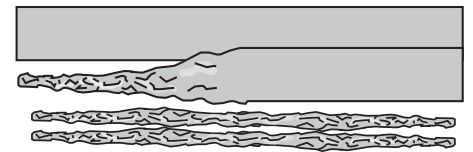
Card, scissors, kitchen foil, sticky tape, bright/shiny paper, glue



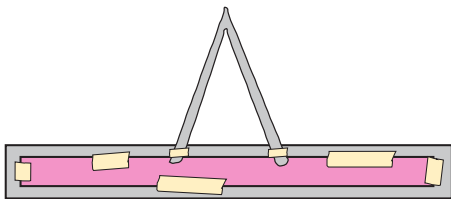
1. Cut a band of card to fit around the head with a bit extra to overlap.



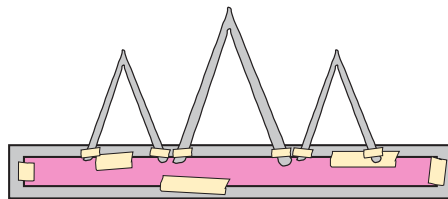
2. Lay it on some kitchen foil and fold in the edges and tape them down.



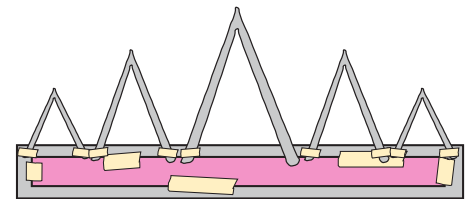
3. Cut out four strips of foil the same size as the band and squeeze them together to make them into sticks.



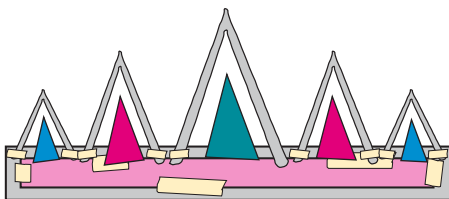
4. Bend one of the sticks in half and tape it onto the back of the band in the middle.



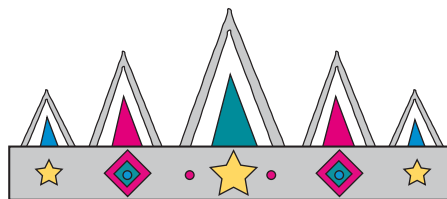
5. Take two of the sticks and cut a little from the end of each one and bend them in half and stick either side of the middle one.



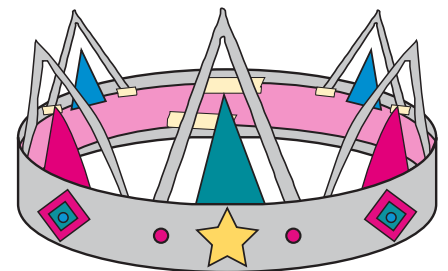
6. Cut the last stick in half, bend both pieces and stick on each end.



7. Cut out shapes from your brightly coloured or shiny paper and stick them on so you can see them above the band.



8. Turn the band over now and glue on shapes of shiny paper or foil, or anything else you can think of to decorate your crown.



9. Finally, tape the ends of the band together to make your crown.

Note: These are activities for you and your child to enjoy together. The safety of your child is obviously very important. Please use caution when using scissors and other materials in your child's presence.
