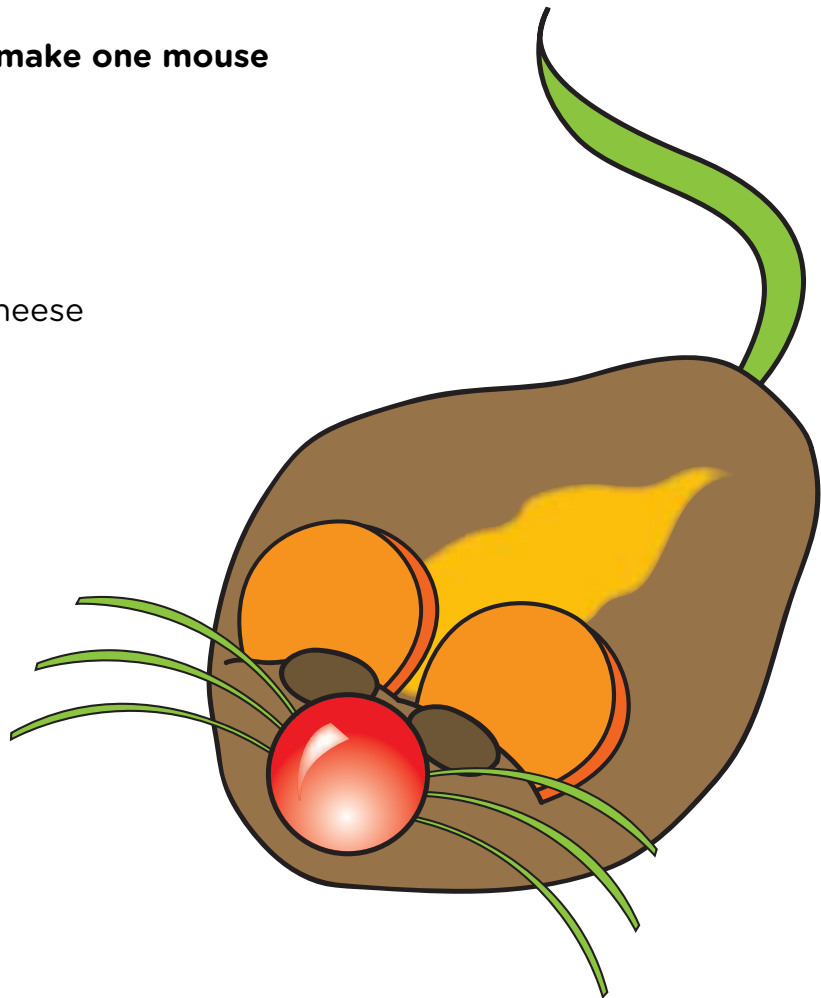


Squeals on Wheels

Bored of dull old jacket spuds? Try making these fun mice in jackets (you can add other things and make your own vegetarian-friendly edible animal or use baby veg to make mini mice).

Here's what you'll need to make one mouse

- A large warm baked potato
- Some raisins
- A cherry tomato
- 2 slices of carrot
- A small handful of grated cheese
- A knob of butter
- A small bunch of chives
- 1 cocktail stick



Make sure your potato isn't too hot to handle and cut the top off so you can scoop out the insides. You don't need the top so eat it! Put the potato you scoop out into a bowl and mix it with the cheese and butter and pop it back into your spud. You may need to put it back into the oven for a couple of minutes just to warm it through again. Stick your ears (carrot slices) into the front end of the hole you cut out (see picture). Criss-cross three long chives behind the cherry tomato and secure with a cocktail stick (don't eat this!). Drop on the raisin eyes and sit your potato on a tail-like chive... eat quickly before it escapes!

Note: These are activities for you and your child to enjoy together. The safety of your child is obviously very important. Please use caution when using scissors and other materials in your child's presence.
