Ingredients

Cornflakes or Rice Krispies

One bar of cooking chocolate

Sweets for decoration

You will need

Pan of hot water or microwave oven.
You will need an adult's help here.
Microwaveable Plastic bowl
Wooden spoon for mixing
Baking cases



- 1. Break chocolate into small pieces into a plastic bowl.
- 2. Either put into the microwave on full for 1 minute (you may need to do this again if the chocolate hasn't melted) or put the bowl over a pan of hot water and stir carefully. Ask an adult to help you.
- 3. Keep stirring until all the chocolate has melted.
- 4. Add the Cornflakes or Rice Krispies a spoonful at a time.
- 5. Keep on mixing together.
- 6. When the mixture is ready put a spoonful into each baking case.
- 7. Drop some jelly tots or other brightly coloured sweets on the top.
- 8. Leave the cakes to cool and set.
- 9. Yum, yum they are now ready to eat. I wonder if grandma would like one?
- 10. You could have a pirate party just like me and invite all your friends but don't make anybody walk the plank will you?

TIP: Putting your home-made cakes in a nice box or bag will make an excellent gift for family or friends. **Note:** These are activities for you and your child to enjoy together. The safety of your child is obviously very important. Your child must be supervused at all times when using the oven.
