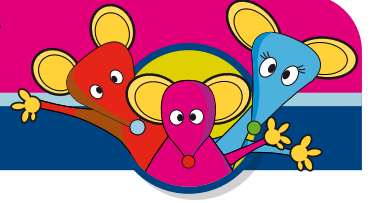

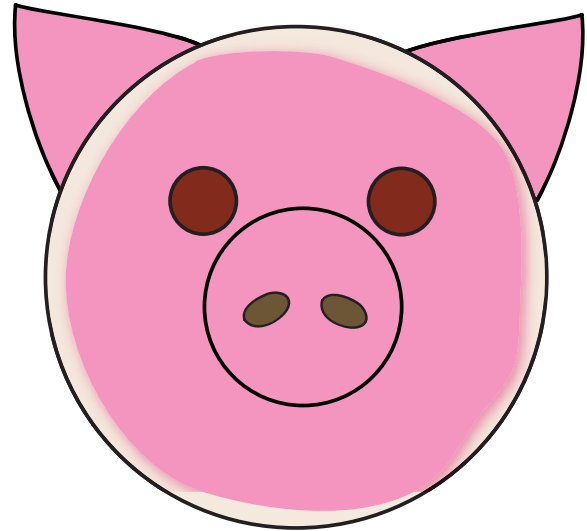


Farmyard bagel

Oink, oink, here's a sweet farmyard treat that will put a smile on everyone's faces.

Here's what you'll need to make one pig:

- Half of a plain bagel
- 3 Pink marshmallows
- Half a cup of icing sugar
- Pink food colouring
- 2 Raisins
- 2 Chocolate buttons



Here's what to do:

Preparation time: 5 minutes

Assembly time: 30 seconds

Eating time: As quick as you can munch!

First get all your pieces ready. Leave one marshmallow whole and carefully cut the other two into triangular ear shapes. Then mix the icing in a cup with a couple of drops of food colouring and a few drops of cold water. The mixture should be smooth and not too runny. If you put too much water in add some more icing sugar. Next assemble, pop your full marshmallow into the bagels hole and then spread your icing around it with a butter knife. Attach the chocolate button eyes, marshmallow ears and raisin nostrils with tiny blobs of the icing as in the picture. Allow to set and eat.

Note: These are activities for you and your child to enjoy together. The safety of your child is obviously very important. Please use caution when using scissors and other materials in your child's presence.
